

About Rajmala Welfare Society (RWS)

RWS, a Support Centre for Trans Women, Youth and Queer in Crisis was set up in November 2013 in Ghaziabad , Uttar Pradesh, to ensure a holistic response to discrimination and violence across the sexual spectrum on the basis of gender, religion, caste & class. It is collectively managed by a group of activist volunteers. Currently it is registered as a Non-profit organization in Ghaziabad. The Centre has provided a wide variety of support services to 820 trans- women survivors (from April 2022-March 2023). The support includes paralegal, legal, medical, social mediation, counseling, rescue, shelter and rehabilitation. Often it is a struggle for women in Uttar Pradesh to access the police system for justice. Over the years RWS has enabled many women to register their cases with the police. To create an enabling environment for gender equality and equity RWS also works in 25 communities and 20 schools and colleges of Ghaziabad division which includes the districts of GB Nagar, Noida and Greater Noida.
